#### TIMETABLE STRUCTURE

#### Slot duration

Our timetable slots are two hours (e.g., 09:00-11:00) and consist of two lessons starting at each hour within that slot, lasting for 45 minutes (e.g., either 09:00-09:45 or 10:00-10:45).



#### Student assignment

Students will be assigned to one of these two slots to maintain smaller group sizes (e.g., either 09:00 or 10:00).


### What are Condensed and Express GCSE courses?

- Covers core topics to ensure exam readiness with a clear, structured approach.


#### **Express GCSE Courses**
